Our senior volunteers and the Coordinator could also attend and speak at prestigious platforms, highlighting the importance of reading habits in empowering communities with minor and script-less languages.

Teaming up with different agencies and NGOs was another efforts that showed excellent results. The Tezu Dist. Library actively joined hands to celebrate library functions, while the District Library Namsai, honoured our reader-activists & volunteers by facilitating conducting a 10 days' reading promotion activities for school students of Namsai in Feb 2024. District Adult Education Officer, Tezu, CDPO, Tezu and NGOs Wildlife Institute of India, Anjaw; Aaranyak, Guwahati & AMEYA, Roing also enabled us to hold different programmes. The read Aloud training sessions for Tezu students RASA-2 was another success.

A great honour for the Library movement was when our volunteer Ms Behelti Ama, a fine-arts student at Kalakshetra Foundation, Chennai, was selected to present her painting in a Wildlife Art exhibition by MoEF, GOI at the Rashtrapati Bhavan in Oct 2023. Earlier she had held an art exhibition series "Art Miscellany" in May 2023 at Tezu, Roing & Dibrugarh. The Carnatic music recital by Wakro Sisters (Ashapmai Dellang & Behelti Ama), at AIR, Tezu & Itanagar & at Roing and Dibrugarh was another landmark. The Library also hosted a Theatre workshop by trainer Ms Ashadevi, Kerala, a Kaman Mishmi language translation workshop, and a pre-CBSE exam learning enrichment workshop for class X students at Yealiang Govt Sec School in rural Sunpura. Visits and interactions by eminent guests was a remarkable feature of the year 2023-24.

Of great happiness to the Library Movement was the substantial increase in the number of reader-visitors to the HQ Bamboosa Library. With an average increase of 35% in visitors. It reinforced our conviction that a Library should be a platform with a variety of activities strengthening reading habits.


